

Ride a Bicycle Safely

Be careful the following situation not to get traffic accident while riding a bicycle.

- ① Don't ride double or ride side by side.
- ② Don't ride while using an umbrella or holding objects in your hand(s).
- ③ Don't ride while talking on a cellular phone or looking at its display.
- ④ Don't ride in a way that prevents you from hearing traffic sounds and voices which are necessary for traffic safety (e.g. listening to the radio with headphones).
- ⑤ Don't race or zigzag.
- ⑥ Don't ride between cars in heavy traffic.
- ⑦ Don't ride after drinking alcohol.
- ⑧ Be careful of cars turning left at junctions.
- ⑨ Always use your light at night and in tunnels.
- ⑩ At railway crossings, stop, check that it is safe, and push your bicycle across.
- ⑪ Slow down or stop when approaching children, the disabled or the elderly.
- ⑫ When parking your bicycle, make sure it does not obstruct any pedestrian or vehicular traffic. Use bicycle parking areas if they are available nearby.
