(Qualification Summary)

1. Qualified Applicants

- ① Trainees must be nationals of developing countries in Asia, Africa, and the Middle East.
- ② Trainees preferably belong to a company or organization in the Kanto Region or in the Yamanashi, Nagano, or Niigata Prefecture.
- ③ Trainees must be studying a specific engineering development theme (preferably civil, electrical or agricultural engineering, or development economics).
- ④ Trainees who are recommended by the company or organization to which the trainee belong.
- ⑤ Trainees are not permitted to be in receipt of another scholarship in 2013 fiscal year.

2. Amount of grants

From Yen 80,000 to Yen 120,000 per month.

(The amount of grants will be determined by the Managing Committee every year.)

3. Scholarship period

April 2013 ~ March 2014 (1year)

4. Number of Scholarship Recipients

12 students in Japan

5. Notice of Selection

Notice of the result of the selection will be given, in writing, to the applicants by the in late April 2013 via the company or organization to which the trainee belongs.

6. Report on training or study

Trainees who are selected are required to submit a report concerning their training or study every six month, during the period in which they are receiving the grant.
