(Qualification Summary)

### 1. Qualified Applicants

To qualify for this scholarship, applicants must be privately financed students who are enrolled in the University as an undergraduate or as a graduate student, and are from one of the following countries : Bangladesh, Bhutan, Brunei, Cambodia, India, Indonesia, Lao, Malaysia, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Philippines, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Thailand, East Timor, Viet Nam (Note: Japanese Nationals and Research students are not qualified.)

In addition, applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Students are interested in international understanding and goodwill and will be able to attend Sato Foundation Meetings (meetings will be held six times a year.);
- ② Students have not received and will not receive any scholarship or study grant from any other foundations for the academic year of 2013;
- ③ Students have a “college student” visa;
- ④ Students do not have a parent who works in Japan;
- ⑤ Students do not have a doctoral degree;
- ⑥ Students’ enrollment period will last for more than one year beginning from October 2013 or from April 2014;
- ⑦ Students are able to communicate in Japanese;
- ⑧ Students are able to cooperate actively with international exchange programs as SATOM after finishing receiving this scholarship. (SATOM is alumni of Sato International Scholarship Foundation)

## 2. Monthly Award

Undergraduate Students: 120,000 yen

Graduate Students: 180,000 yen (There is also financial support available for participating in academic conferences related to your study program.)

## 3. Scholarship period

October 2013 ~September 2015 (2years)

April 2014 ~ March 2016 (2years)

## 4. Number of Scholarship Recipients

About 15 students in Japan

## 5. Selection and Result

- Primary Selection Phase: Screening of application documents
