O Outline of the course

Japanese language education

a) Term: October 1st, 2018 through March 31st, 2019(6 months)

b) Curriculum:

Intensive courses for learning basic communication skills including "Basic Japanese", "Chinese characters and writing", "General Japanese", "Japanese and Computer", and "Japanese culture".

c) Examination and evaluations systems

Students are evaluated holistically by Quiz, Mid Term Exam, Presentation, class attendance, and attitudes during the class.

Specialized training

a)Term: April 1st, 2019 through March 31st, 2020 (1 year) b)Curriculum
