The Birthplace of Ground Golf: Yurihama, Tottori Prefecture

Ground golf was developed in the town of Yurihama (formerly Tomari Village) in Japan's Tottori Prefecture in 1982. With simple rules that allow anyone to enjoy the game, ground golf's popularity has spread throughout Japan, as well as abroad.

The Hometown Park of Ground Golf: *Shiokaze no Oka Tomari*

The hometown park of ground golf, *Shiokaze no Oka Tomari*, is a ground golf course specifically designed for the sport and has been approved by the Japan Ground Golf Association. With a view looking out across the ocean, it is an ideal location with a total of 3 different courses and a multi-purpose lawn area. Various ground golf tournaments are held at *Shiokaze no Oka Tomari* throughout the year, bringing players together from both inside and outside of Tottori Prefecture.

Day 2: 20 May 2018 (Sunday)

Players will play 8 holes on the 1 course that they did not use on the first day of the event.

Other: 1. Clubs and balls used must be approved by the Japan Ground Golf Association.

※Markers will be provided and free rental equipment will be available for use.

3. All participants will receive event memorabilia and a certificate of participation.

4. Please refrain from canceling on the day and call to the follow beforehand when there are unavoidable circumstances.
