

Permission to Engage in Activity Other Than That Permitted under the Status of Residence Previously Granted (Part-time work)

Since your Status of residence is “College Student”, while you stay in Japan, you are expected to be engaged only in activities as a student, such as study and research. In this respect, if it is absolutely necessary that when you work part-time, you must obtain permission from an immigration office before you can start such activities.

But if you work as a teaching assistant or research assistant in Tottori University, you don't need to apply for this permission.

Notes) It is strictly prohibited to obtain work in sexual entertainment industries.

*After July 9th, 2012, this permission may be given at the port of entry to persons who enter Japan for the first time and are granted “Student” status with the permitted period of more than 3 months and apply for it.

Status of Residence	Permitted Hours for part-time work
“College Students” status Regular students, Non-regular students, Research students or Special auditing students	Within 28 hours per week *Or, within 8 hours a day during long holidays such as Summer, Winter or Spring holiday.
“Dependent” status	Within 28 hours per week
