IMPORTANT NOTICE

1. INFECTION PREVENTION

- ① Monitor your physical condition, including body temperature, for 2 weeks prior to the date of your medical checkup (health observation period).
- 2 Be sure to fill out the Health Observation Record, otherwise you CANNOT take examination.
- ③ Those who have fever and/or other health problems on the day of medical checkup or during the health observation period CANNOT take examination.
- 4 If you have infected with an infectious disease (COVID-19, flu, etc.), and are still under medical treatment period CANNOT take examination.
- ⑤ Those who have been requested by the Public Health Center to undergo health monitoring or refrain from going out as a person who has been in close contact with a patient with COVID-19 CANNOT take examination.
- 6 If any of the above 3, 4 or 5 applies to you, please contact with Health Science Center in advance.
- 7 Be sure to wear a mask.

2. Chest X-Ray

- 1 Wear thin fabric shirt with no buttons, prints, or glitters.
- ② Bring something to wear such as a jacket and a cardigan to protect you from the cold when you get to the X-ray bus.
- ③ Do not wear necklaces or bras during the X-Ray examination.
- 4 Make sure that your hair is not falling over your shoulders.

3. Urinalysis

- 1 You cannot submit only your urine sample without taking examination.
- 2 (For ladies) Notify at the reception desk if you are on a period. The Health Science Center will inform you of the sample submission date later.
