1. Qualified Applicants

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Students are from one of the following countries: China, Korea, Mongol, Taiwan, Cambodia, Philippines, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, Thailand, Viet Nam (Note: Japanese Nationals are not qualified.)
- ② Students must be privately financed students who are enrolled in or will be enrolled in the University as a graduate student or have finished PhD course and continue to study to receive a doctoral degree.
- ③ Students whose major are related to Natural Science; Engineering, Science, Agriculture and a part of Faculty of Medicine (Major in Molecular Pathogenesis or Public Health)

- ④ Students in Master's course must be under 30 years old and Students in PhD program must be under 35 years old as April.1, 2013.
- ⑤ Students will not receive any scholarship from any other foundations for the academic year of 2013.
