

The use of face masks became mandatory in public places in La Paz




This park is mainly for sports, but it is also a reforestation project. To the date, diferents volunteers have planted more than 3,000 trees.

LA PAZ

First let me introduce about La Paz

La Paz, capital of the state of Baja California Sur (BCS), Mexico. Is the favorite destination for nature and



adventure lovers.

La Paz, It lies about 12 metres above sea level on sheltered La Paz Bay of the Gulf of California (also called Sea of Cortez) and has a hot dry climate.

La Paz La Paz was founded in 1535 but became the territorial capital in 1829.

It is an important tourist center mainly for its marine activities but also for its great contrast with the desert. Is also an important commercial and agricultural port. The city had a 2020 census population of 250,141 inhabitants,making it the most populous city in the state.



The Northwest Biological Research Center (Cibnor) was created in 1975 by decree of the Government of the State of Baja California Sur and Conacyt (National Council for Science and Technology). Its initial objective was to promote scientific and technological development in the region.

They focus on the training of human resources, technological development, and innovation in the field of science and in the use, management and preservation of natural resources.

CIBNOR has 3 postgraduate programs master's and doctorate in "Management and Preservation of Natural Resources" and doctorate in "Interinstitutional in Fisheries and Aquaculture Bioeconomy" also have 4 units centers outside of La Paz.

CIBNOR has a long relationship of exchange and technical and scientific collaboration with the University of Tottori.





UABCS





The Autonomous University of Baja California Sur (UABCS) was created on December 31, 1975.

The University has educational services in the five municipalities of Baja California Sur, La Paz Campus and four Academic Extensions: Guerrero Negro, Loreto, Ciudad Insurgentes, and Los Cabos.

UABCS has 21 university degrees (16 degrees and 5 engineering degrees) and 8 postgraduate courses.

The university has more than 15 years of academic collaboration with the University of Tottori.
